Week 1	Self Introduction Presentation	Self Introduction How to write a simple outline for a self introduction speech.	Prepare and present self introduction speech Students are able to speak in front of a small audience, build confidence and learn techniques in this lesson.
Week 2	Evaluate Speeches	Evaluate Speeches It takes practice to evaluate speeches as you listen to them. We will look at body gestures as well as content.	Live evaluation on speeches Learning to offer constructive feedback can help put the speaker's mind at ease and make the event go more smoothly.
Week 3	Narrative Speech	Narrative Speech Helping students to essentially using transitions to weave their story together but in an organized manner. A major consideration when writing the narrative includes deciding how to deliver the speech.	Narrative speech and self evaluation Giving memorable speeches has a lot in common with good storytelling. A good storyteller captivates his audience with a story. Students will determine exactly what it is they want their listeners to get from your speech. Students will understand the importance and improve on their narrative speech through self evaluation.
Week 4	Descriptive Speech	Descriptive Speech A descriptive speech is to provide a detailed, vivid, word picture of a person, animal, place, or object.	Is the image the same for everyone?
